

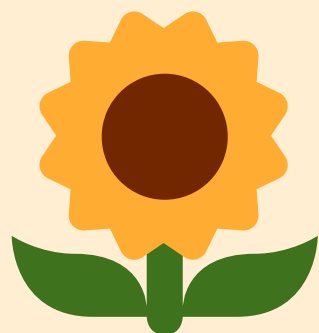
# BLESSED JULIE

1906

## Julie's Shrine

**January, 1906**

Julie's shrine is ordered from the Dehin Factory of Liège. Four crests recall the participants in Julie's beatification: Pope Pius X, Cardinal Ferrate (Protector of the Institute), Monsignor Heylen (Bishop of Namur), and the Sisters of Notre Dame (whose crest had been created in 1903 for the purpose of the beatification).



## Solemn Recognition of the Relics

**April 9, 1906**

Julie's relics are authenticated by Monsignor Heylen, Bishop of Namur. They are able to be offered to the public for veneration.



## Celebrations in Namur

**May 17-21, 1906**

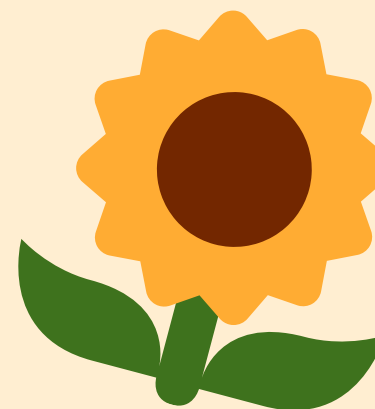
Processions with Julie's shrine and celebrations in the Cathedral of Saint Aubain.



## Decree of Beatification

**March 19, 1906**

Pope Pius X publishes the decree which declares Julie Blessed.



## Celebrations in Rome

**May 13, 1906**

Pope Pius X declares Julie Blessed in the Basilica of Saint Peter of Rome. The age and the health of Mother Aimée de Jésus do not permit her to make the trip. The celebration is recounted in great detail in the Annals of the Congregation: it must have been great and glorious!
